Additionally, he spent a year as a clinical neuro-oncology fellow at the National Institutes for Neurologic Disorders and Stroke. Dr. Jagannathan is one of only a few neurosurgeons in Michigan to perform all open and minimally invasive procedures related to complex spine, spinal oncology and deformity, including open and percutaneous pedicle screw fixation, TLIF, ALIF, DLIF, vertebroplasty, kyphoplasty, and spinal radiosurgery. He is also trained to perform artificial disk replacement using Prodisc-C and Prodisc-L technology. Dr. Jagannathan was recently featured as being among the "Top Doctors in America" in Delta Sky Magazine and was named a "Spine Surgeon to Know" by Beckers Spine Review. He has also been featured in Hour Detroit magazine's "Top Docs" issue and has received the Patients' Choice Award and Compassionate Doctor Recognition from Vitals.com the past three years.
